

Holy Family Catholic School's **Playschool Program**

Holy Family's Playschool Program follows a child-centered curriculum emphasizing play and exploration. It provides children with socialization and prepares them for continuing education at Holy Family School. Our program is open to potty-trained children aged 2.5 and older and is supervised by experienced teachers.

The Playschool Program is open from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and is divided into two sessions. A 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. session, which includes free play, instructional time, lunch, and recess, while those who choose to stay until 2:50 pm will have rest time and snacks.

Parents may enroll their child 2, 3, 4, or 5 days per week. You will be charged according to the number of days you have committed to, not the number of days attended.

Before attending the program, each student **MUST** have a completed registration packet, a valid Kentucky immunization record, and the \$20 registration fee paid. There are **NO** exceptions to this rule. This program is bound by laws set forth by the state of Kentucky and governed by the Division of Regulated Childcare through the Office of the Inspector General.

Holy Family's Playschool **Informational Packet**

Welcome to Playschool! This packet contains all the information needed to make your and your child's transition to Holy Family School as easy as possible. Please remember that I am here to assist with this transition in any way I can, so do not hesitate to ask questions.

I have been in education for thirty years, beginning as a Speech-Language Pathologist and then transitioning to Early Childhood. I have been at Holy Family School for the past ten years. Our assistant teacher, Ms. Krista, has a social work and mental health counseling background. This is her first year with our program.

Our goal in Playschool is to create a nurturing and engaging environment where children can explore, learn, and grow through play-based activities. Our philosophy is fostering curiosity, building social skills, independence, and introducing pre-academic skills through play and active engagement.

Our classroom uses the *Mommy and Me* preschool curriculum, which utilizes weekly themes. These themes include "All about Me," "Dinosaurs," "Community helpers," "Space," and "Polar animals". To encourage learning, we incorporate hands-on activities, such as water play, crafts, sensory bins, science experiments, and small and large motor activities.

This program is bound by laws set forth by the state of Kentucky and governed by the Division of Regulated Childcare through the Office of the Inspector General. It undergoes yearly inspections and is required to post violations in the classroom. Please review the guidelines and our inspection reports at your convenience.

We ask that you use our FACTS program to pay tuition/fees for the afterschool program. Information regarding FACTS is available in the school office.
